Black Bean Salsa

Ingredients

- 1 can kidney beans, drained (15 ounces) · 1/4 cup finely chopped onion
- 1 can black beans, drained (15 ouces)
- 1 can corn, drained (15 ounces)
- 1 can crushed tomatoes (15 ounces)
- 1 can chopped green chilies (4 ounces)
- · 1 tablespoon oil
- · limes, juiced (3 limes, optional)
- · salt (to taste, optional)

Instructions

- 1. Mix kidney beans, black beans, corn, tomatoes, chilies, and onion in a large bowl.
- 2. Add lime juice (if using) and oil, toss gently to combine. Taste. Add a small amount of salt and pepper if desired.
- 3. Serve by itself, with raw vegetables and/or corn chips.
